This session aims to foster an informal dialogue on advancing policy change at the EU level through an HIV Outcomes Call to Action. It will highlight HIV Outcomes' priority proposals for a new EU Action Plan on HIV/AIDS, focusing on the long-term health, well-being, and health-related quality of life of people living with HIV. This Call to Action will be presented to the newly elected policymakers in the European Parliament following the EU elections.
